Power Box Solution.

The aesthetic of the Fuel powerbox is simple and elegant with clean lines making it both visually appealing and physically sturdy. There are four Fuel models to suit the widest possible range of user requirements and work environments.







01 Shelving

The internal “shelving” of Fuel boxes gives the user the option to position the shelf in two locations. The higher mount will result in a large area for storing excess cables and also provide easy reach to the outlets by the user. The lower position works better in situations where there is the use of apple iPad, and iPhone jacks which are large and will prevent the lid from closing if positioned at the higher mount. The push action magnetic catch prevents the lid from falling open when it is fitted into a folding table and the table is in the stowed position.

02 Fixing plates

The fixing plates have been designed so they can adjust from 12mm to 50mm thick worktop. The set down of the anodised lid allows for a leaf of veneer or laminate to be applied to the lid to match the table top. The anodised lid is very serviceable and doesn't show finger marks from use when it is opened and closed on a regular basis.

03 Sizes & dimensions

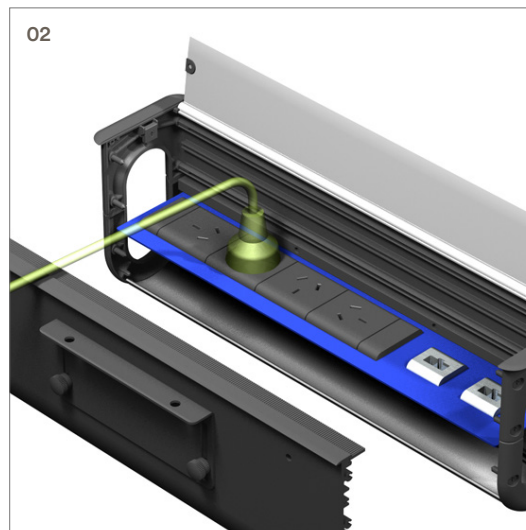
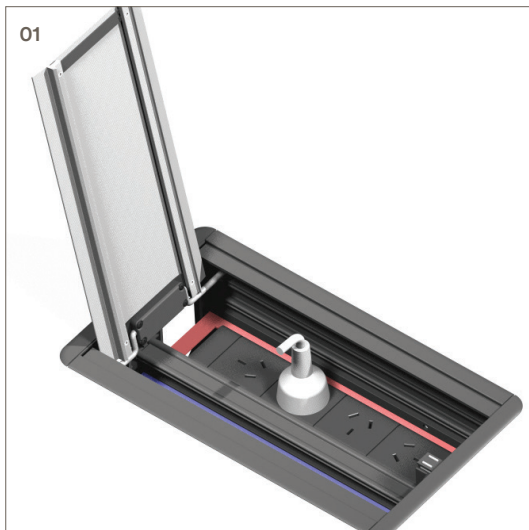
Fuel 90 – single-sided access best suited to small tables, folding tables, workstations and desks. Internals include 4GPO and cut-out for 3 data. 400mmL x 85mm W x 138mm H

Fuel 91 – single sided access has internal capacity for 8GPO and 10 data cut-outs. Primarily used in a large boardroom table that needs lots of provision for power and data. Fuel 91 can be positioned as doubles in the worktop for ease of reach by user. 1000mmL x 85mmW x 138mm H

Fuel 95 – double-sided access has capacity for 4GPO and cut-out for 4 data – there is also a 100mm punch-out to allow for AV, HDMI components to be installed. 300mmL x 165mm W x 138mm H

Fuel 98 – double-sided access has capacity for

4GPO and cut-out for 4 data – there is also a 100mm punch-out to allow for AV, HDMI components to be installed. 400mm long x 210mm wide x 138mm high. This design straddles the central beam which exists on the single leg frame of the I.A.M, UR, Incognito and okidoki table bases from ThinkingWorks. The design of the Fuel 98 can span a 46mm dia rail. Not suitable for folding tables.
